

22		480 x 720	A happy family circle. Their house is located in the poor residential area of the capital. Las Palmas, El Salvador 1982






















44		800 x 1200	Training mujahideen (Islamic fighters). More than 10 thousand men gathered from all over the country to fight as Islamic fighters. Daste dek, Panjshir, Afghanistan 1983
45		900 x 600	Massoud and others visiting influential persons in the local areas so as to organize a united front against the Soviets. Andrab, Afghanistan 1983
46		480 x 720	Massoud visiting a base called Karalga. It is hollowed out in the rock. Panjshir, Afghanistan 1988
47		480 x 720	Lamps were gathered by the villagers of a small village when they greeted Massoud. He visited this village during his travel to organize the war against the Soviets. Farkhar, Afghanistan 1983
48		480 x 720	Massoud listening to the information provided by one of his supporters from Kabul. He had such supporters not only in the government offices but also many in the ranks of the police forces and government troops. Bazarak, Afghanistan 1983
49		900 x 600	On the way of crossing a mountain, Massoud heals his fatigue by listening to the chanting of the Qur'an. Asking where he wants to visit, he replied “I want to see the Blue Mosque in Istanbul and the Islamic architecture in Cairo. Panjshir, Afghanistan 1983
50		900 x 600	After cleansing the body in the Pahnjshir River, Massoud performed a prayer. He looked like speaking to God. Bazarak, Afghanistan 1983
51		480 x 720	Massoud sending out Islamic warriors on the truck. He organized the Islamic forces and was successful in the battles with the Soviets. Bazarak, Afghanistan. 1983
52		480 x 720	Holding a mujahid's child in his arm after reading a book in the fields during his travel to organize the united front against the Soviets. Parandeh, Panjshir, Afghanistan 1983
53		480 x 720	Massoud reading a letter from an old friend who escaped to Pakistan. He said “If I loose a friend, I feel like there's a hole in my heart”. Daste Dek, Afghanistan 1983
54		1000 x 1500	Massoud reading a book alone in the mountains. He was no different from a young person in a peaceful country. Parandeh, Panjshir, Afghanistan 1983
55		900 x 600	After finishing a meeting with the commanders, Massoud enjoys the fragrance of roses on the way back to his office. Taloqan, Afghanistan 1990
56		900 x 600	Fandeele, a boy whose family was taking care of the Islamic warriors. He looked like a fairy in the woods. Farkha, Afghanistan 1988
57		900 x 600	A nomad girl chasing the sheep. On the way to the summer camp from Panjshir Valley. Jangalak, Afghanistan 1983
58		1000 x 1500	Massoud and armored vehicles from the government troops heading for Kabul after they took the Mazare Sharif Fort in the north. Bagram, Afghanistan 1992
59		480 x 720	Massoud and his men heading towards the capital Kabul. He was able to persuade the other parties to form the Islamic interim government after receiving a proposal from the socialist government to hand over the power to the antigovernment forces. Jabul Saraj, Afghanistan 1992
60		480 x 720	On the move straight to Kabul. Agreement was broken by Hekmatyar with an ambition to gain power of the government, and his group started another fighting. Bagram, Afghanistan 1992
61		480 x 720	Massoud being greeted by the advance troop at the headquarters in Kabul. Soon afterwards, he was appointed Defence Minister. Kabul, Afghanistan 1992
62		800 x 1200	Massoud's average sleeping time was about four hours. He went into deep thought during intervals of solving problems brought to him by people from time to time. Bazarak, Panjshir, Afghanistan 1983
63		800 x 1200	Massoud and his warriors crossing the steep Hindu Kush mountains (altitude 4,800 m) to negotiate with the opposing guerrillas in the Andrab district. Cotal Baba, Afghanistan 1983

64		1000 x 150	At a riverside, Massoud and his men eat watermelons which were given to them by local farmers. gave watermelon to us and eat at beside a river. Massoud said “In the future I would like to do trade business. I wish to import things which the Afghanistan people would like to have”. Taloqan, Afghanistan 1990
65		1000 x 150	Massoud and his party being greeted at a village. Carpets from all over the village were brought to the party. Banquet was offered to them frequently by villagers who wanted to fight with him but cannot do so for certain reasons. Farkhar, Afghanistan 1983
66		600 x 900	As the Defense Minister, Massoud made a strong effort to cease fire, but fighting between factions continued. His anguish deepened more and more. Kabul, Afghanistan 1995
67		800 x 1200	The Islamic extremism group Taliban supported by the Pakistan military advanced close to the capital. Government tanks prepare the defense of capital. Kabul, Afghanistan 1995
68		600 x 900	A woman in chaddle walks around to gather firewood for cooking during fights between factions. Kabul, Afghanistan 1995
69		600 x 900	The Hekmatyar group attacked the capital indiscriminately with 2,000 rockets from the suburbs. They were pushed out from the city. Kabul, Afghanistan 1995
70		600 x 900	Massoud offering a prayer. He never gave up even when the Taliban seized 90 percent of the country, and even when many media were saying “The Massoud group lost the fight”. Farkhar, Afghanistan 1999
71		600 x 900	Massoud gazing at his hometown Panjshir from the flying helicopter. He decided the retreat from Kabul to avoid destrcution of the capital. Bazarak, Afghanistan 1999
72		600 x 900	Massoud reading a book with a penlight in the dark. This was after the commanders who gave up their petitions for more arm, food, blankets and shoes and left him as a matter of course. He was unable to respond to any petitions from them. Bazarak, Panjshir, Afghanistan 1997
73		600 x 900	Massoud discussing overnight with the finance officer. This was in the midst of danger of the administrative collapse, military defeat and shortage of financial resources. Farkhar, Afghanistan 1999
74		800 x 1200	New fighters after military drill. They joined Massoud with a common idea “Even we are not given arms, we want to fight for our hometowns”. Tahar, Afghanistan 2000
75		1000 x 1500	“My favorite place is the Kabul University campus.” said Massoud on a hill at the front line against the Talibans. But he was not able to enjoy full peacefulness. Shomali Plain, Afghanistan 2000
76		900 x 600	Massoud's tomb on a hill overlooking his hometown Panjshi. He was killed by a suicide terrorism. Saricha, Panjshir, Afghanistan 2001
77		800 x 1200	I asked Massoud “Are you scared of getting old?” He said “Why? It is natural to get old” with a charming smile. Tahar, Afghanistan 2000
78		600 x 900	Black workers at an ironworks. Their wages were one fifth of their white colleagues even though they do the same work. Johannesburg, South Africa 1992
79		600 x 900	Burning of tires on the street as a part of the conflict between the blacks. Johannesburg, South Africa 1994
80		1000 x 1500	Plantation workers at lunch. Their food provided by the white plantation owner was very bad, but they had a bright expression. Pretoria, South Africa 1992
81		600 x 900	Solomon, a miner working at the Durban Deep Gold Mine 3,700 metere below ground level. Johannesburg, South Africa 1994
82		480 x 720	Solomon dressed in his finest clothes went back home for Christmas holiday. He meets an old friend who works as a shepherd. Visconti Village, South Africa 1992
83		480 x 720	Finally, he gets time with his wife, Dida at home after a busy time with guests. Visconti Village, South Africa 1992
84		480 x 720	Solomon returned to the mine after a three day vacation. Dida and their children sent him off brightly though they have to wait another one year to see him back. Visconti Village, South Africa 1992

89		600 x 900	A girl attending school with a flower which she picked from the streets. This was after the Kosovo War ended. Pristina, Kosovo 1999
90		480 x 720	A woman shedding tears at seeing her home burnt down. She came back on a truck from Macedonia where she sought refuge. Petit, Kosovo 1999
91		480 x 720	The market regained its liveliness. 80 percent of the town's houses were set fire. The market was also in ruins for one time. Petit, Kosovo 2000
92		480 x 720	Children starting to clean up the mess of their ruined home in front of their parents in despair. The home was destroyed by the war. Petit, Kosovo 1999
93		900 x 600	Shekelsen's name means 'shining'. He is the third son of the Zebit family. Bukowitz Village, Kosovo 1999
94		480 x 720	Shekelsen on the move with his cows for grazing. His family survived the war with cow's milk by hiding in the mountains. Bukowitz Village, Kosovo 1999
95		480 x 720	Shekelsen watching his grandmother milking the cow. The cow was brought back from grazing. Bukowitz Village, Kosovo 1999
96		480 x 720	Children running out of the home to eat the falling snow. Shekelsen in the center, while having his elder brother on his right and his cousin Kadlier on his left. Bukowitz Village, Kosovo 2000
97		800 x 1200	Klassnietzsche family all together. A large family of three generations with 33 family members as a total. Bukowitz Village, Kosovo 2000
98		480 x 720	Zabit's eldest daughter Cebu Dye helping the house building. Everybody in the family work together for the house building. Bukowitz Village, Kosovo 2003

107		900 x 600	A boy aiming for a bird with an arrow. The arrow head is shaped with a three-pronged fork so as capture the bird unhurted. Demini Village, Roraima State, Brazil 1995

155		600 x 900	An Inuit returning to his settlement from a seal hunting. They used to visit their relatives in Canada with dog sleds across the frozen Artic Ocean. Qeqertarsuaq, Greenland 2009
