Notices to visitors











Services that are suspended until further notice:

- Extended opening hours on certain days of the week.
- Discounts such as Silver Day and Family Day that attract crowds.
- · Library by appointment only.
- Hand dryers in restrooms and water coolers in the museum.

Requests to visitors:

 Temperatures will be taken at the entrance to the museum. Visitors who have a high fever or symptoms such as coughing, sore throat will be refused entry.

• Refrain from visiting the museum if you have traveled within the past two weeks to countries or regions where infections are continuing to increase.

- Visitors who have had close contact with people who turned out to be positive of COVID19.
- Visitors who suspected infections with family or friends.
- Visitors with large luggage over 55cm high will be refused entry.
- · Visitors without masks will kindly be refused entry.
- Please wearing a mask, avoiding coughing near others, washing and disinfecting your hands.
- Please follow to keep Social Distancing in the museum.
- · Please cooperate with cashless payment.
- Minimize conversation and do not touch the wall, exhibition cases in the gallery.
- Please take note of the date and time of your visit as for your reference.
- Please let us know immediately, if you are not feeling well.

Facility use:

- The entrance is the main gate and west only. South entrance, the 2nd floor, is closed.
- Elevator capacity is 4 limited. People with disabilities, elderly people, and pregnant are given priority.
- Restriction of the number of visitors in order to prevent overcrowding.

Measures taken by TOP MUSEUM to prevent the spread of infection:

- Museum staff conduct daily temperature checks and confirm that they are in good health.
- All staff wear masks, faceguards, and gloves as necessaries.
- · Acrylic panels installed at the reception counters and so on.
- · Disinfectant placed at the entrance to the museum.
- Thorough cleaning, disinfection, and ventilation inside the building.
- · Coordination with the public health center if visitors or staff develop symptoms.
